# NOTICE OF RACE

*In the coastal waters of Bredene the International Patin Sailing Week will be held from Friday 20 July till Monday 30 July. This event will host both the XVIII° Open Belgian Championship ( Friday 20 July – Sunday 22 July ) and the XVIII° European Championship Patin / XI° European Championship Patin Junior ( Saturday 28 July – Monday 30 July ). The International Patin Sailing Week is organised by Twinsclub and Nosepasa vzw, in cooperation with the ADIPAV, Royal Belgian Sailing Federation KBYV, the Flemish Sailing Federation WWSV and neighbouring clubs RNSYC and Ostend Sailing.*

## 1 RULES

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*
- The ADIPAV 2014 "Reglamento de la clase Patin" will apply
- No national prescriptions will apply.
- RRS rule 22.3 is modified so that a boat moving astern shall always keep clear of one that is not.
- RRS rule 40 is changed so that competitors shall always wear PFD's on the water. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.
- RRS rule 44.1 is modified so that a boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 while racing may take a penalty at the time of the incident. Her penalty shall be a One-Turn Penalty ( one tack and one gybe ) .
- Competitors are warned that the championships will emphasize the "NO GOLPES – No damage" action. The Jury will penalise with a DNE a competitor failing to retire after he has to do so according to RRS rule 14 and RRS rule 44.1 b).

## 2 ADVERTISING

- Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

## 3 ENTRY REGULATIONS

- The International Patin Sailing Week is open for the Patin and Patin Junior class.
- Any ADIPAV homologated boat may enter the regatta.
- Competitors shall comply with the international ( Adipav ) or regional ( nosepasa ) class organisation membership.
- Crew substitution of the registered sailor is not permitted.

## 4 ENTRY FEES & ENTRY FORM

- Eligible boats may enter BY COMPLETING THE ONLINE ENTRY FORM and MAKING PAYEMENT BY 15th JULY 2018. Entries will be confirmed when payment is received in full.
- Late entries may be accepted after the closing date at the discretion of the organizing Authority. If accepted, late entries will attract a late entry fee of 25 €

## 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- The Sailing Instructions can be consulted online at least one week before the start of the Championships AND in the Race Committee Office ( Table Of Announcement ). Hard copies will not be distributed.

## 6 SAILS AND EQUIPMENT

- All competitors shall use only one boat, a maximum of 2 sails and 2 masts, which shall be identified during registration.

## 7 SCHEDULE

- Each Championship will have a maximum of 7 races.
- There will be a maximum of 3 races on any day.
- There will be no warning signal made after 15:00 on the last days of the Championships.

### 8 COURSES

- Courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

### 9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- Rule 44,1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

### 10 SCORING

- The regatta will be scored using the Low Point System.
- Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score if a minimum of 4 races are completed. .
- At least 3 races must be completed for the Championship to be valid.

### 11 PRIZES

- Plaques for first, second and third competitors.
- Plaques for first three in the second category.
- Plaques for first, second and third places Patin Junior
- Plaques for first, second and third female Patin competitor
- The Belgian Champion Trophy will be rendered to the first Belgian nationality competitor.
- European Trophy for the first junior, female, veteran, first and second category senior.
- Additional Prizes may be rewarded.

### 12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".
- Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in an event, each competitor (parent for minors) agrees and acknowledges that:
  - 12..1 they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in an event;
  - 12..2 they are responsible for the safety of themselves and their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
  - 12..3 they accept responsibility for any loss, damage, personal injury or death to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
  - 12..4 their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
  - 12..5 the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

12..6 the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

12..7 their boat is adequately insured.

- Nothing done by the organiser can reduce the responsibility of the helmsman or crew of a boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in racing.

### 13 INSURANCE

- Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
